I am very proud to be a part of Hackberry High School and a member of its community.



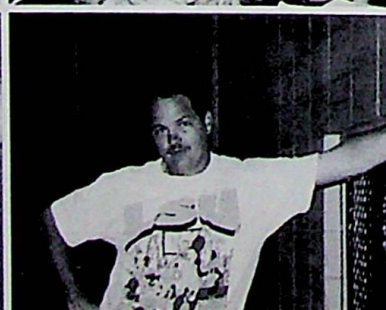
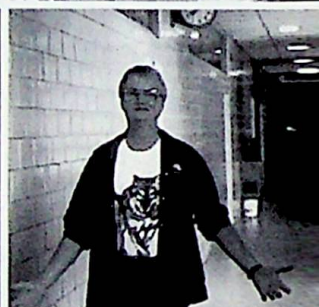

Where does one begin when you start building a structure? What piece is first and more important than the other? For if one piece is missing then the structure will not be strong.

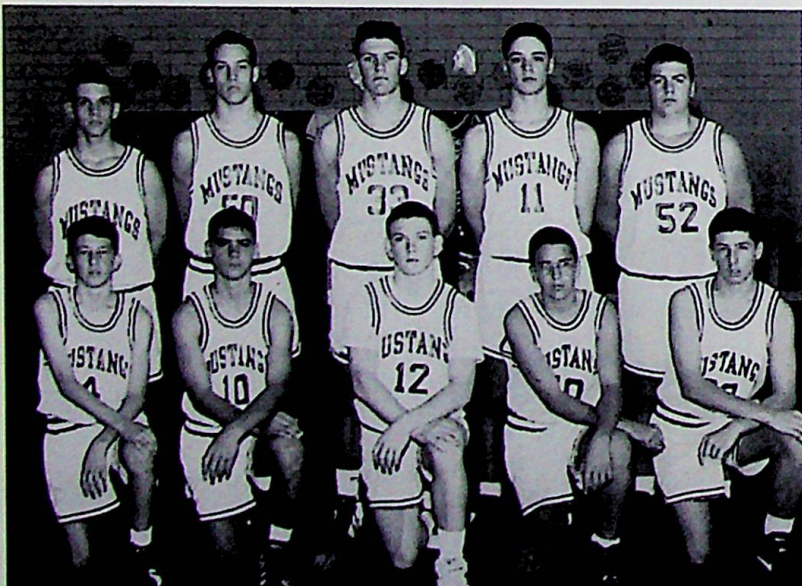
The next question is what kind of structure will you build? Let's build a Basketball Team, and use the parts of a kid. This is only fitting because this game was meant to be played by kids.
