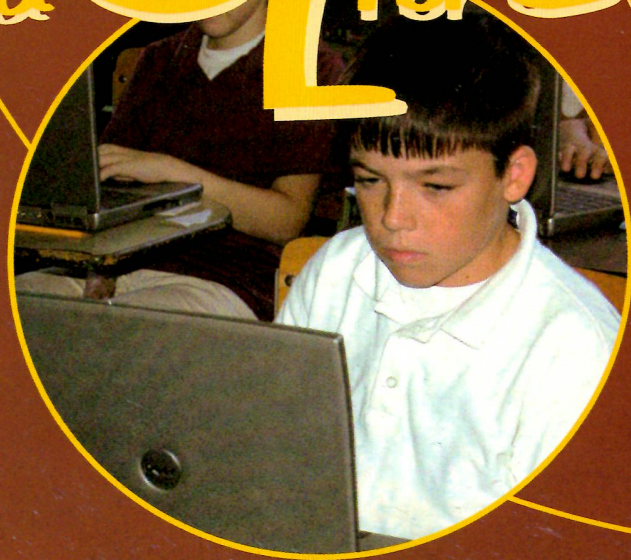

# Now What?

## Rita Took Our Homes, But Not Our Hope

After the evacuation, the hopes for the best, the prayers, the preparing for the worst, and then the shock, the question on every Cameron Parish resident's mind after Hurricane Rita was "Now What?"

Cameron Parish, whose citizens have always been known for being strong and independent, scattered all over Louisiana and several states in order to stay safe from the Category 3 storm. Afterwards, however, the people of the parish were ready to return home to rebuild and start their lives over. Unfortunately, the hurricane severely damaged or destroyed most homes she encountered, and in its tracks left \$10 billion in damage and little to nothing for people to salvage from their pre-Rita lives.

Hurricane Rita did leave the area at a standstill for several months, but eventually positive effects could be seen around Grand Lake. For example, a Dollar General store and a rural health clinic opened their doors in order to help better serve all residents. Though it will be awhile before the community truly sees all the positive and negative effects, it is surely safe to say that the 2005 Hurricane Season will never be forgotten.

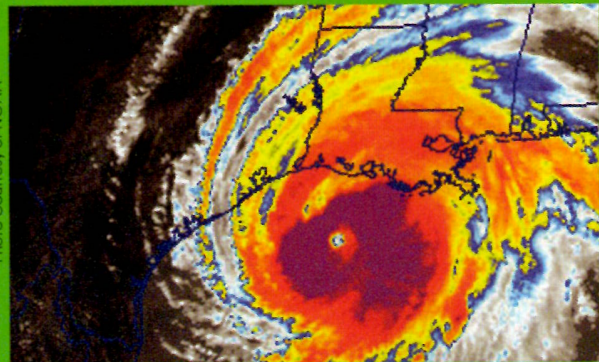

Hurricane Rita Nearing Landfall

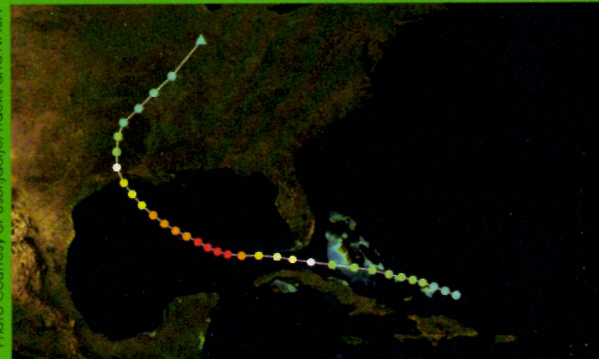

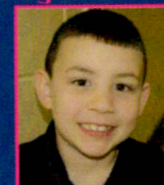

Grand Lake Students Adjust To Changes

Though Hurricane Rita reared her ugly head at Cameron Parish on September 24, 2005, changes and sacrifices followed for several months. Several students' and teachers' homes were substantially damaged during the storm, and they were forced to live elsewhere. Some found temporary homes in Lake Charles, while others moved into FEMA trailers in a relative's backyard. However, the most devastated and unlivable communities were just south of Grand Lake, where three schools were completely destroyed.

What evolved after the hurricane was a stream of proposed schedules that finally ended with the decision that all four schools would share Grand Lake's building by splitting the week in half and adding extra hours to those days. Grand Lake students attended school on Wednesday from 12:30 PM - 5 PM, and on Thursday and Friday from 7:30 AM - 5:00 PM. Several students explained the situation by stating that they literally came to school "sun up til' sun down" for the latter part of the week. Although difficult at times, the new schedule had its benefits as each weekend was extended by two days. Through the yawns and tired groans, the students all somehow survived the year that will never be forgotten.

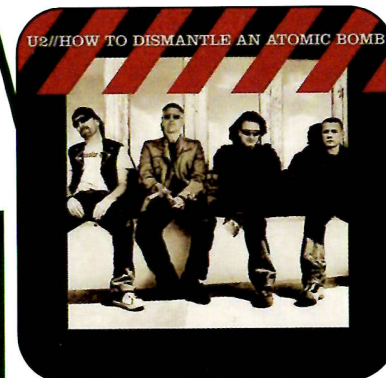

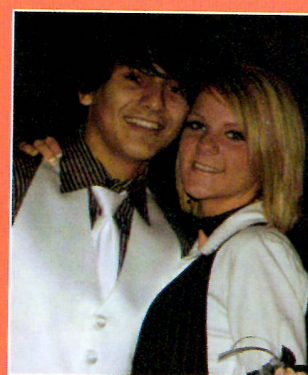


# La Cité de L'amour

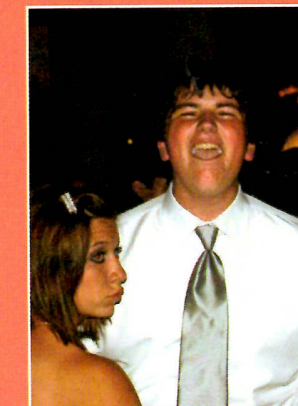

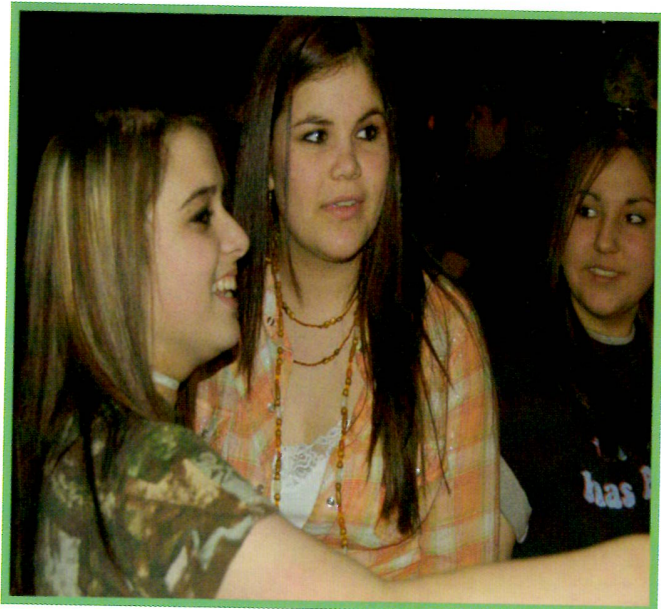

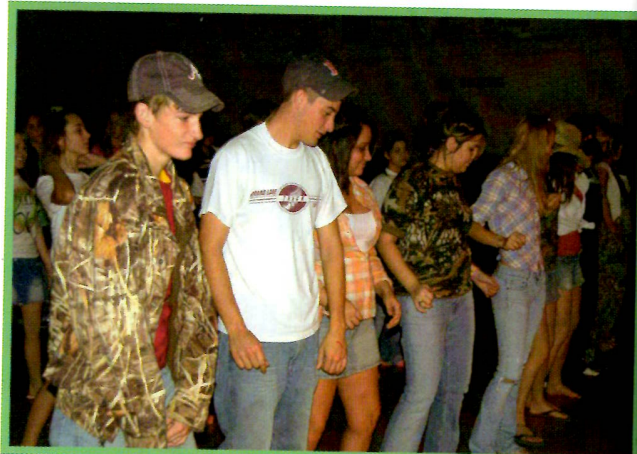

## Miss Grand Lake Ashley Nicole Hunter

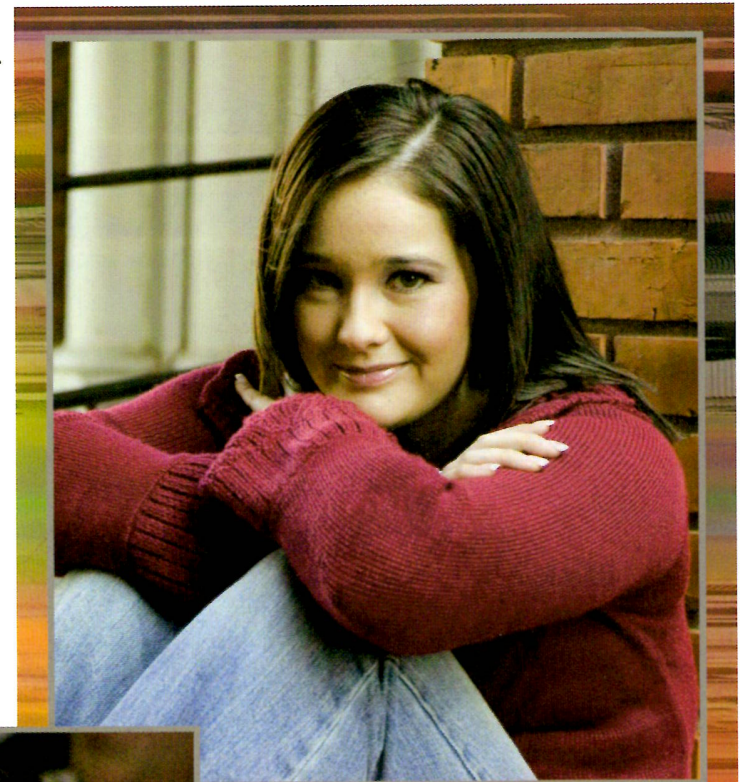

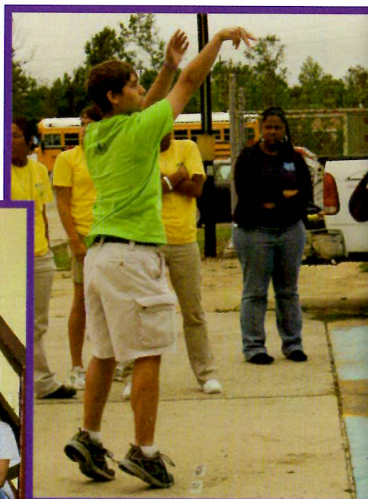

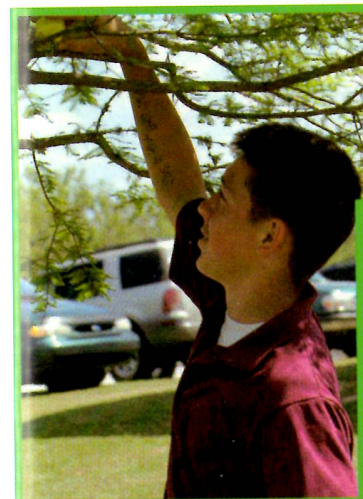

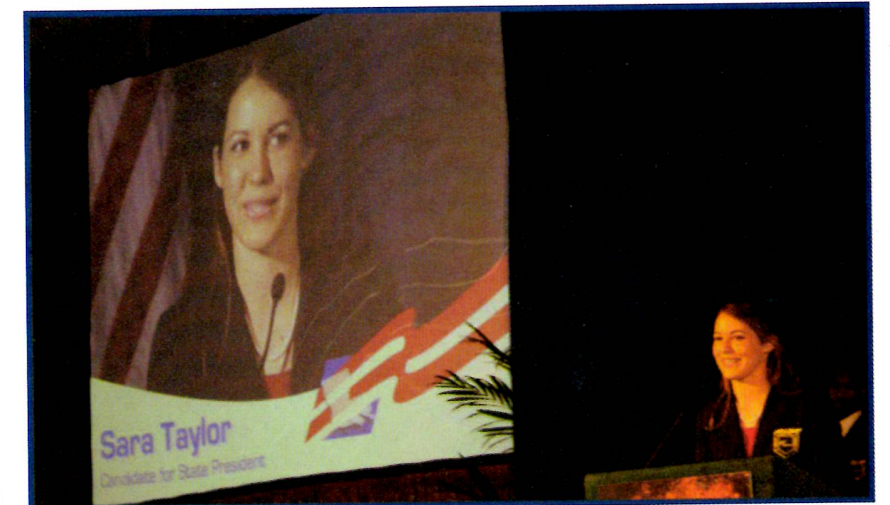

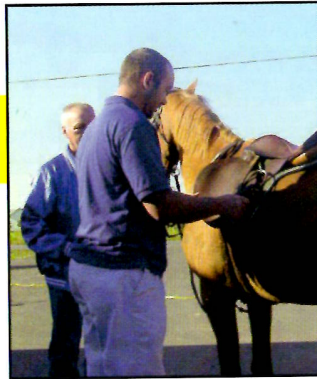


## Spirit of Leadership

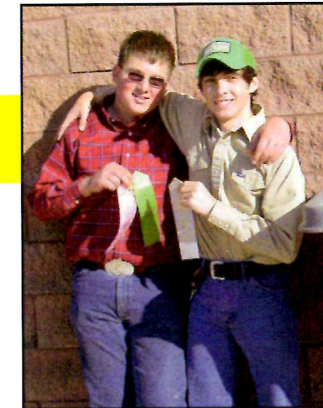

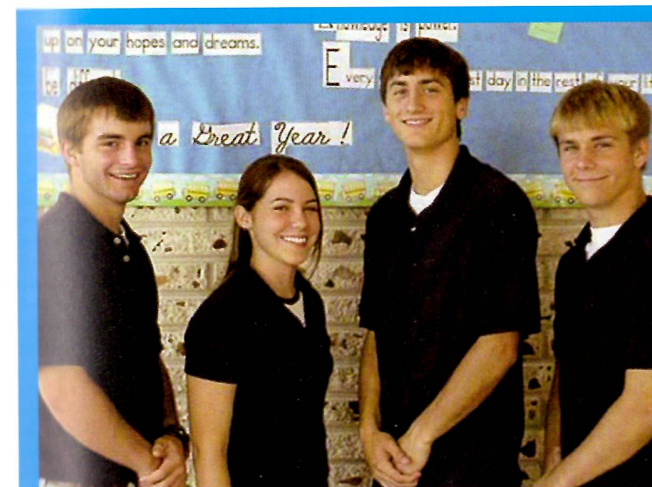

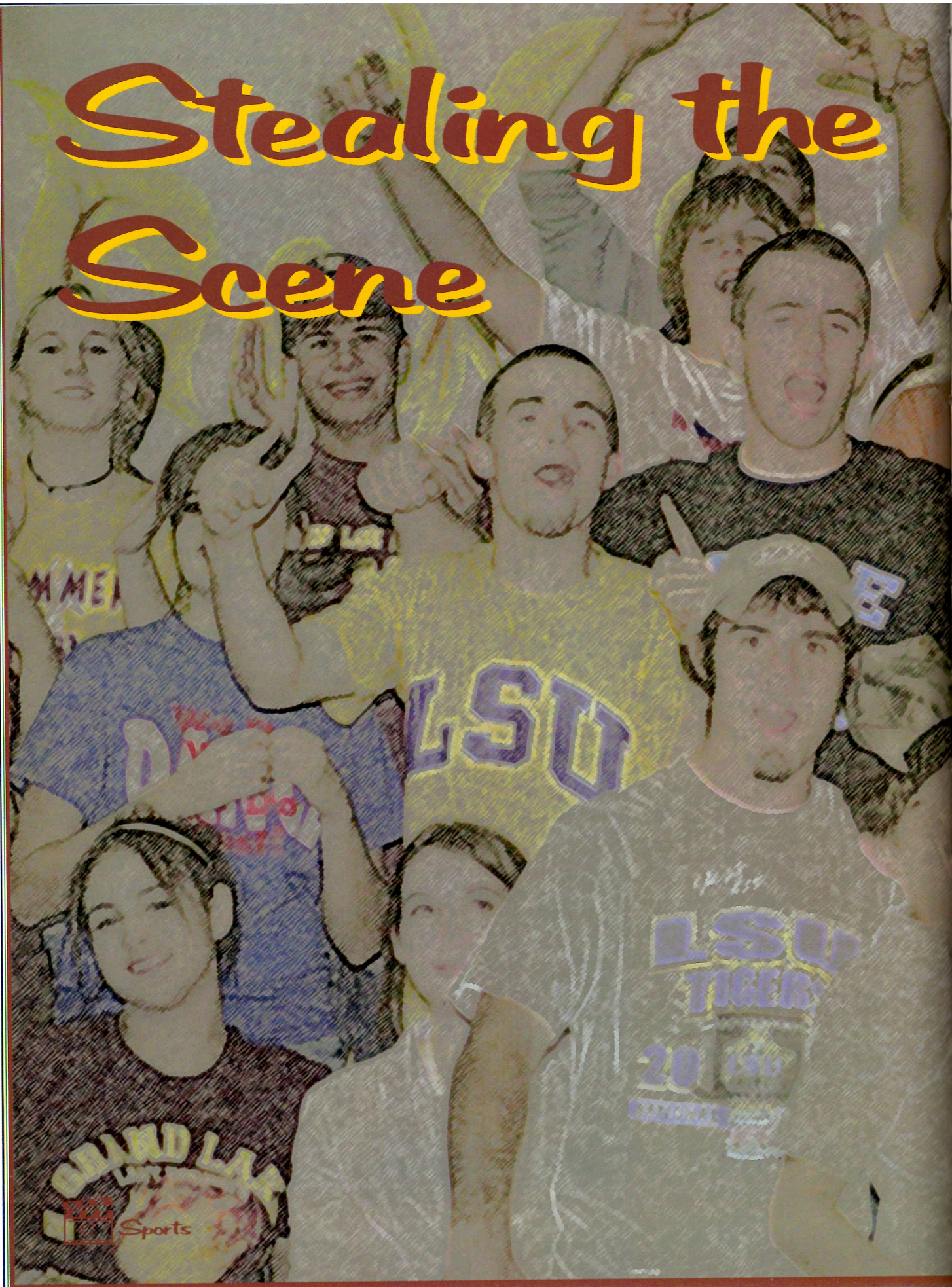

## Sacrifices Pay Off

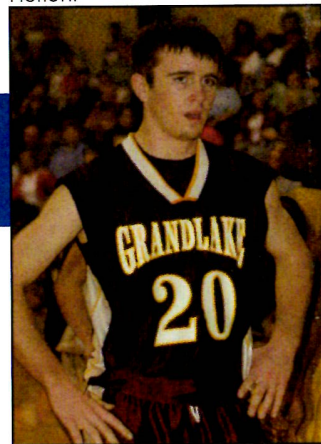

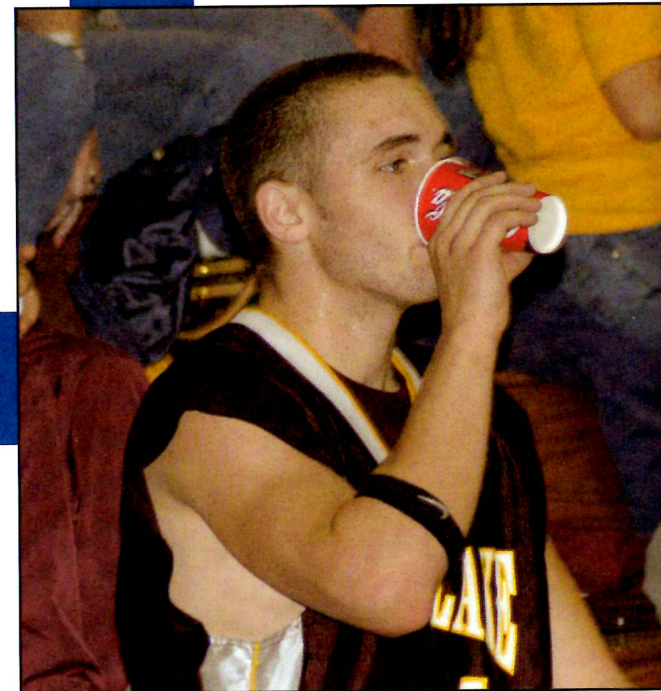

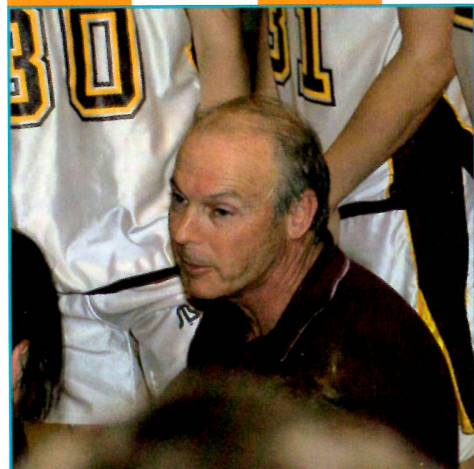

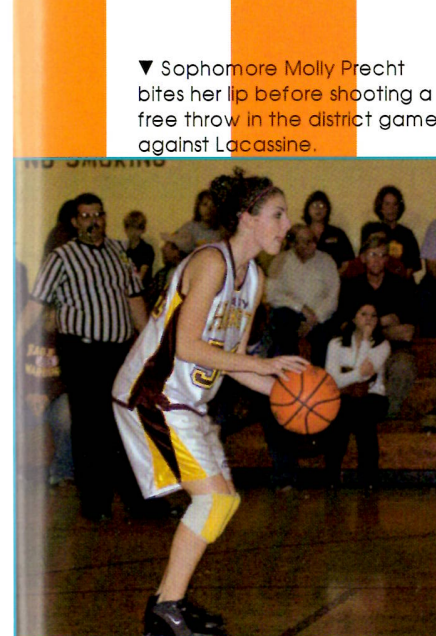

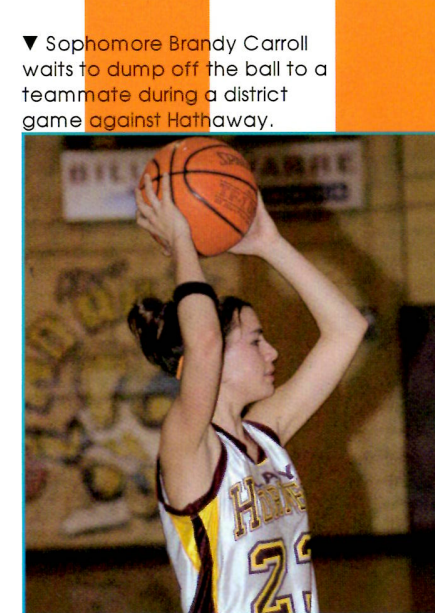

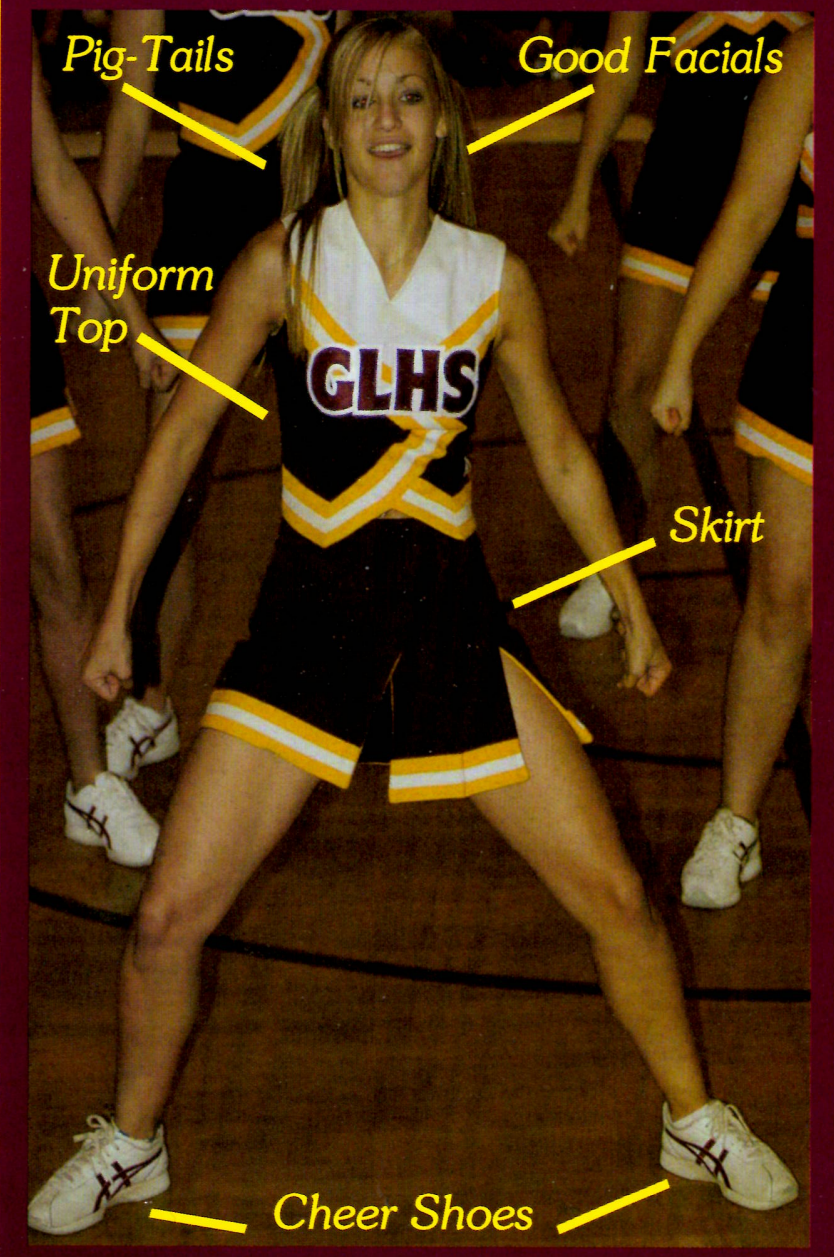

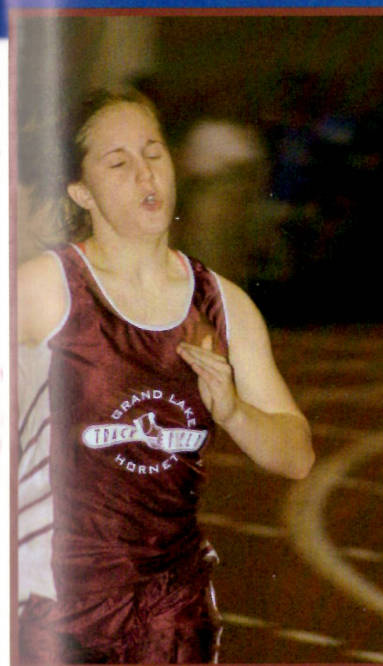
# Against All Odds...

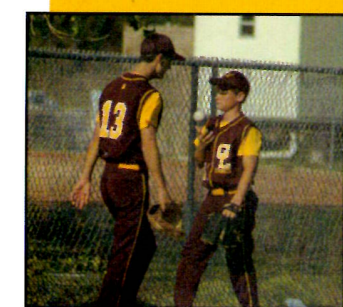

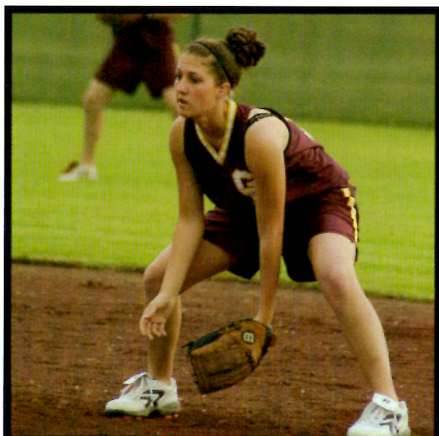

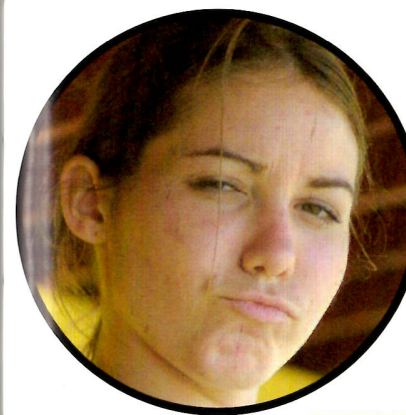

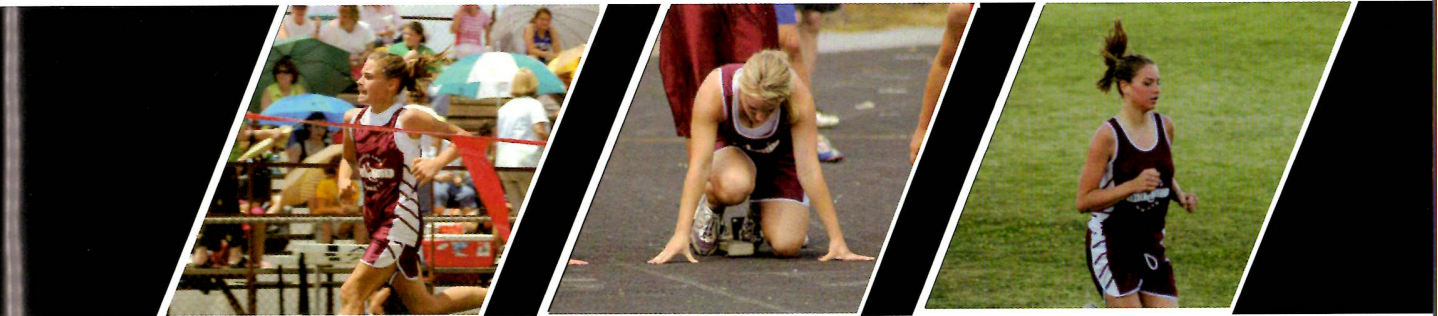

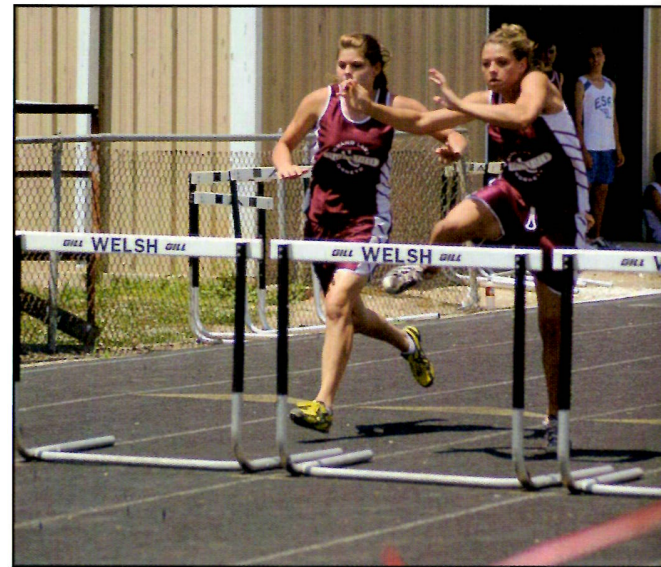

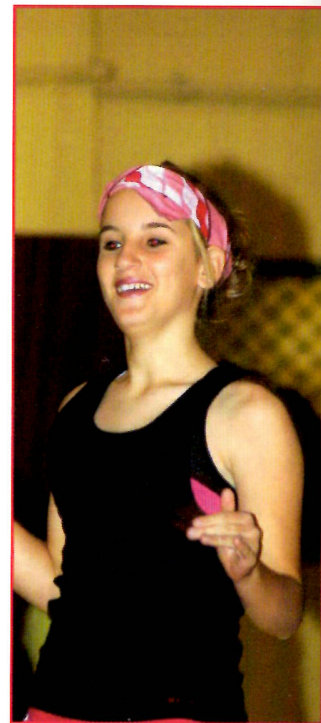

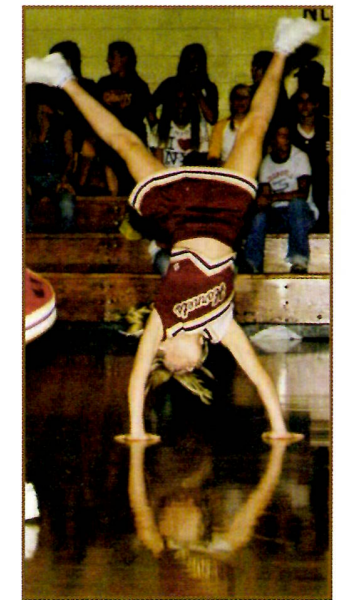
