Football

The Grand Chenier Cowboys have had their best season in four years of six man football, winning four games and losing two in regular season play. They bowed out to Creole for the district championship.

The Cowboys met an overconfident Bell City ball club who had beaten Grand Chenier the three years before, and rambled over the Bear Cubs of Bell City 20-13. The scores came on a 15 yard run by Lyle Crain. Willard Guidry carried the ball over for the extra point. Later in the game, Orrie Canik hit Loston McEvers in the End Zone twice to account for the other twelve points.

The Creole Pirates came down and met Grand Chenier on an off night and left them scoreless, but racked up 33 points for themselves.

Next Grand Chenier met the Hornets of Grand Lake, who showed almost as much improvement over the year before, as the Cowboys showed in previous games. But the hard riding Cowboys managed to down the Hornets 25-21.

Willard Guidry went five and thirty yards for two of the touchdowns. Lyle Crain got 15 yards and six points through the middle for the third score.

The last touchdown came on a pass from Canik to Pat Doland who ran 10 yards. Then Dyson took a pass from Canik in the End Zone for the extra point.

Two weeks later the Grand Lake Hornets came down to play the Cowboys in their second annual homecoming. Grand Chenier showed off their power by racking up 32 points against Grand Lake's 19. The Cowboys' touchdowns came when Loston McEvers caught two passes from Canik for 12 points. Crain, Guidry and Nunez carried the ball across for six points each making a total of 30 points. Crain made it 32 by scoring two extra points.

The Cowboys went over to Creole the following Friday night and met a Creole team who had Grand Chenier out-manned but not out-powered in the first half. Creole sent in substitutes on every play and went on to beat the Cowboys by an overwhelming score of 70-28. The Cowpokes' scores came on two runs by Guidry and Crain for 12 points and two passes from Canik to McEvers to account for the other 12 points. Crain and Guidry drove across for an extra point each and Mhire kicked one straight through the uprights for two points.

The next game came with the Bear Cubs of Bell City which saw 72 points scored with the Cowboys ahead by four points.

The Cowboys' scores came on two runs by Guidry for 12 points, three by Crain for 18 points, and one by Mhire for 6 points. McEvers took a pass from Canik and went across for 6 points. Mhire kicked 3 extra points for 6 more points.

On November 10, the Grand Chenier Cowboys met the Creole Pirates for the District Championship. The Cowboys had three of their first string team out and Creole downed them 60-12. The Cowboys' scores came on a run by Guidry and a pass from Canik to McEvers to make the other six points.

Basketball

The Cowboys' basketball team has started practice under very poor conditions with a limited squad, but hopes to round out into a better than average ball club.

Softball

Grand Chenier had a very successful season last year losing only two softball games for the district championship to Landry High School and in the quarter finals to Port Barre at the state tournament.

The Cowboys won all the games in the parish play and won the Parish championship. With this record the Cowboys will begin their 1955-56 campaign losing only one of last years first string men. Hopes are high for a better season and maybe a state championship.

Girls' Basketball

The Grand Chenier Cowgirls started their conference basketball season with a 34-35 victory over the Fenton girls on December 1. Olga Vincent looked good scoring over 15 points. Hilda Miller did well substituting as forward for Jimmie Meaux. The schedule for 1955-56 follows:
