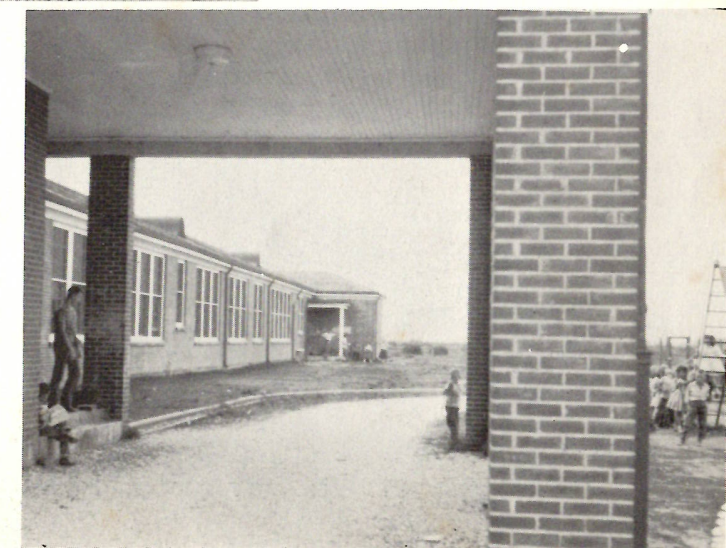
## IN MEMORIAM

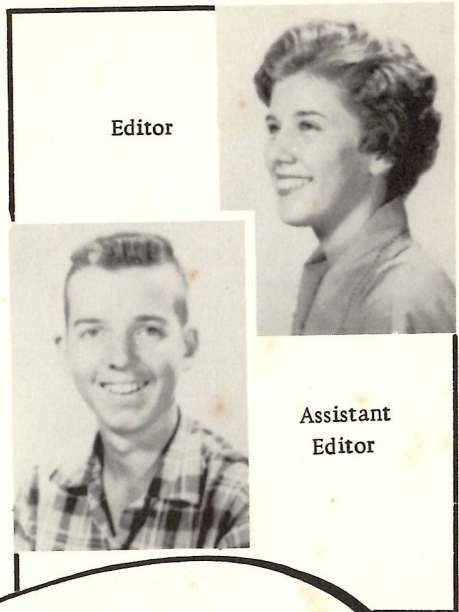
