This being true, why not train yourself to be an agreeable person to live with? One has to do more living with himself than any other person.

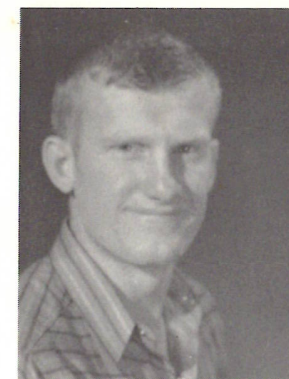
By the time you get your annual and read this message, vacation will be history; and you will be back starting a new school year.
