

We see Julie Trahan finally mastering the ability to hide from Steve Poole while with another boy. (Ha Ha).

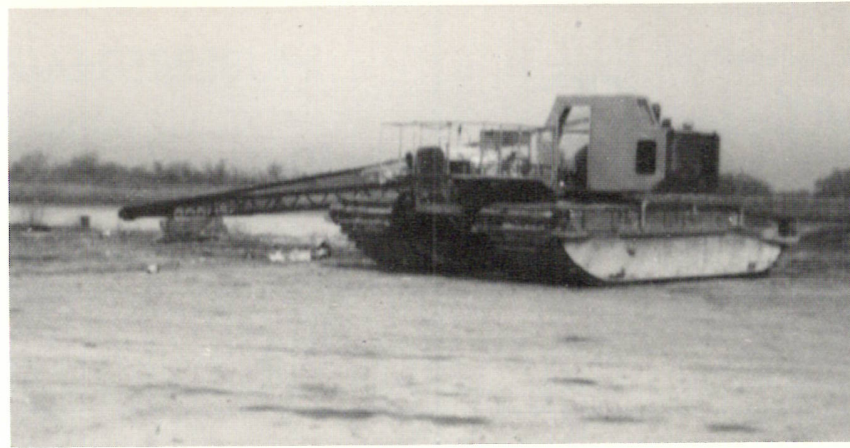
We see David Vaughan, the future Perry Mason, answering the famous year long question "Vaughan how long will you remain a bookie?" his reply was "Always and Forever."

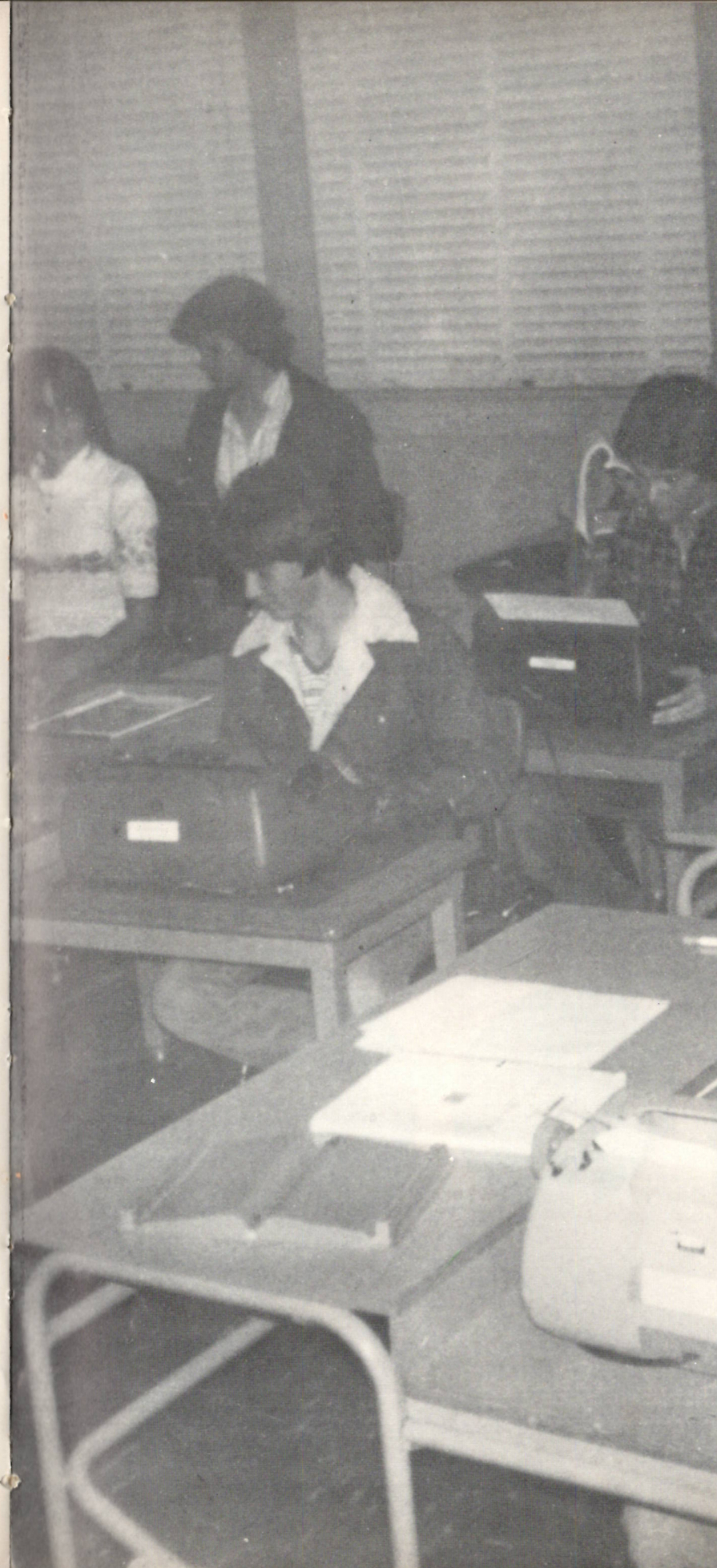
Mr. Debarge's Message
