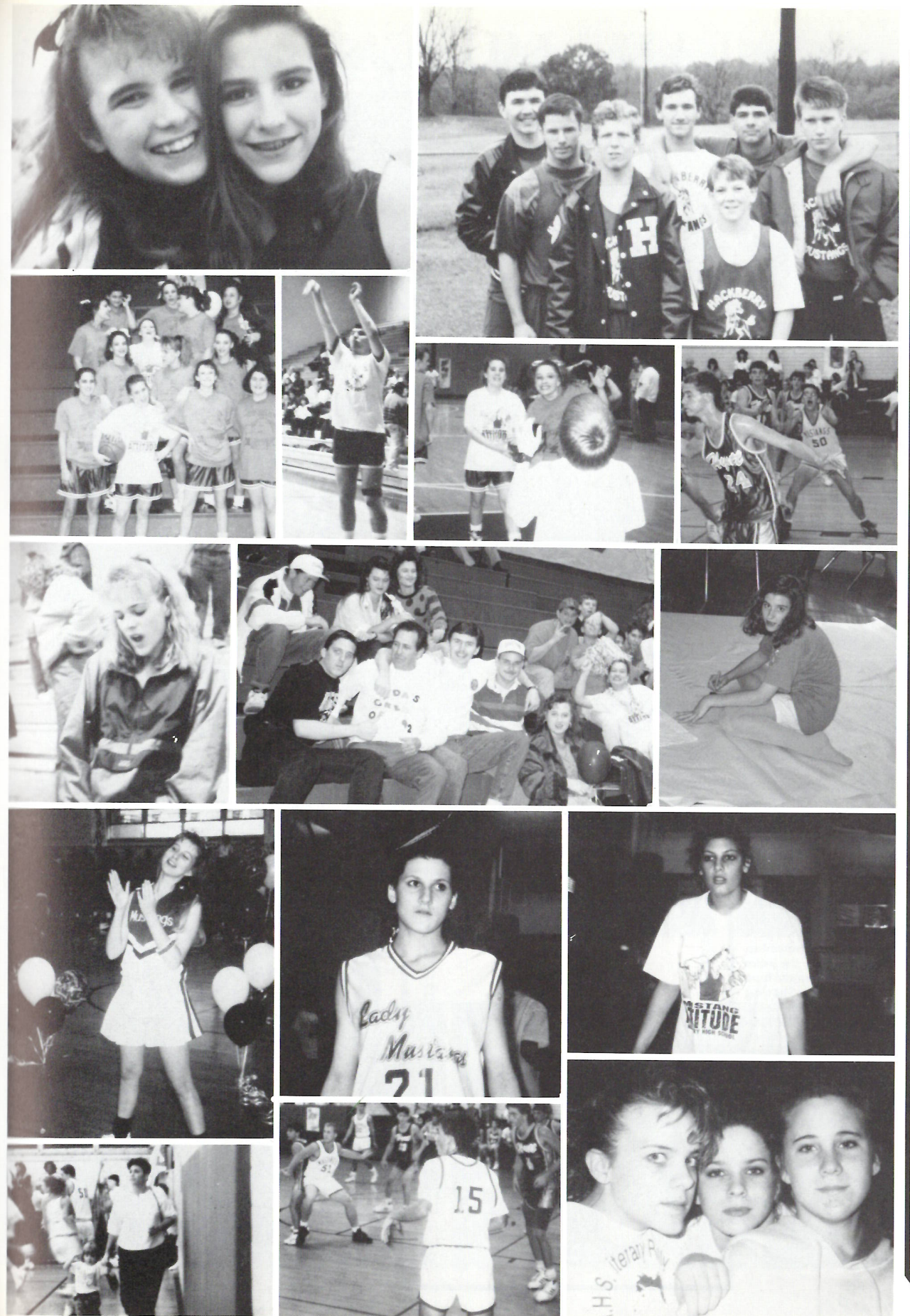


# LIBRARY CLUB
