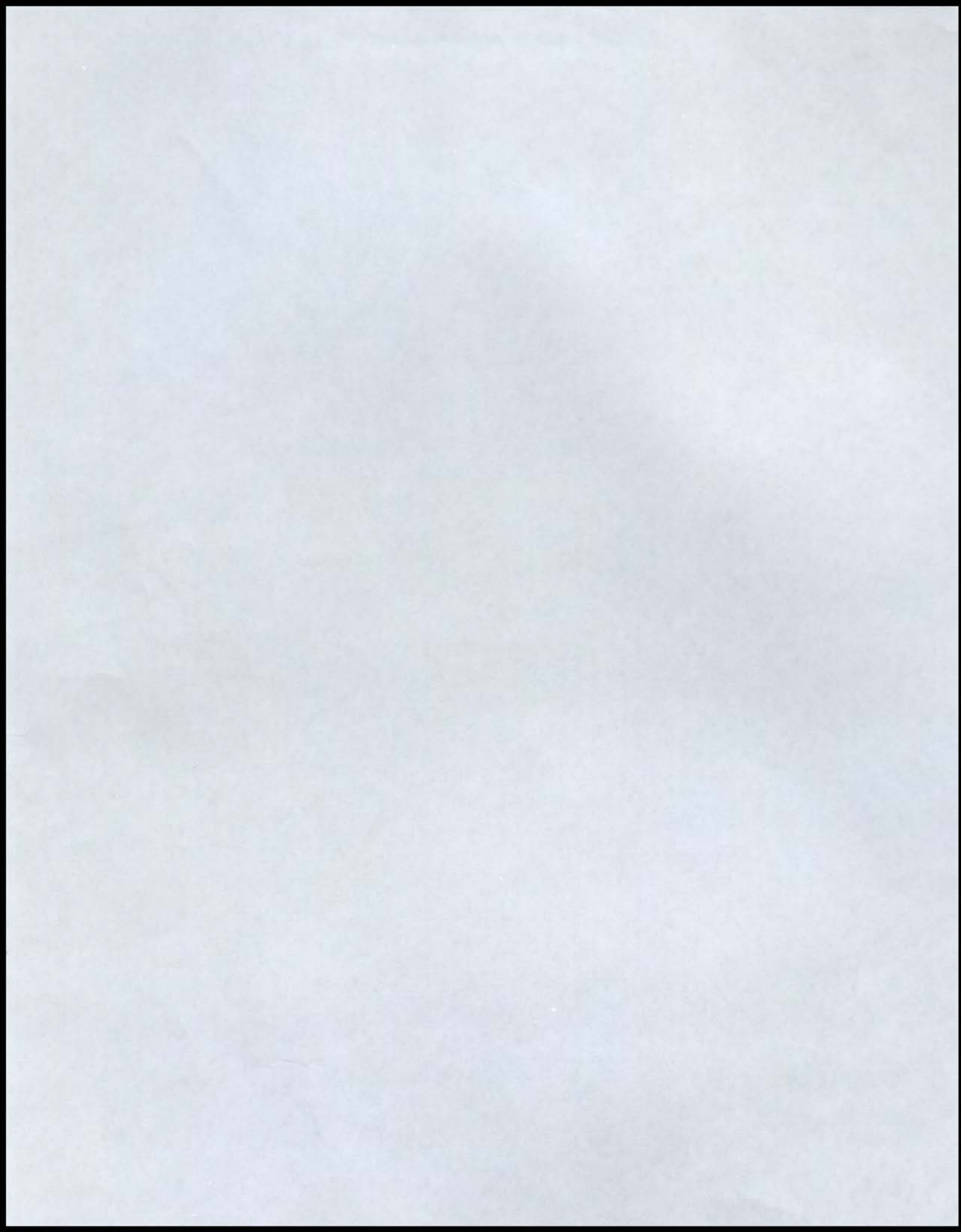

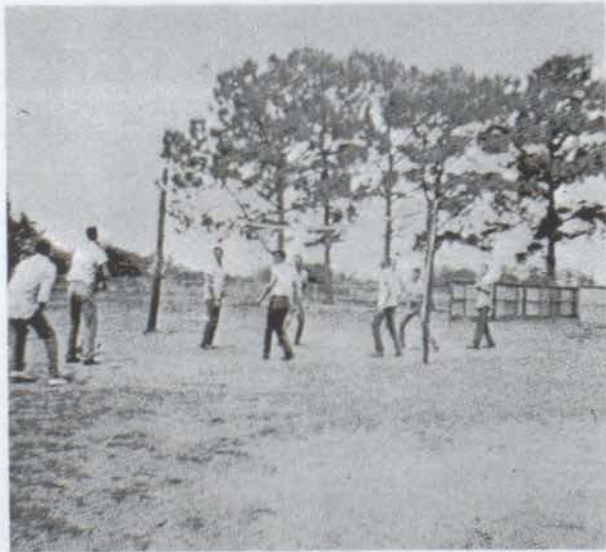


Dedication

Without the support and the encouragement of this community, without the faithfulness and the help of our parents, we would not have had such a successful year.

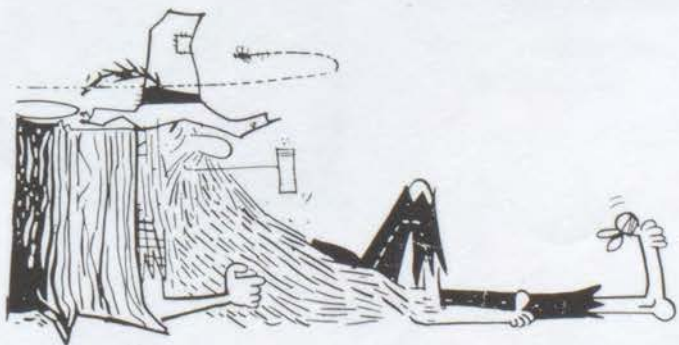
