


Seeing snow once every ten years. An unexpected snowfall on the first Sunday in February gave residents a rare opportunity to build snowmen.







For Sape's Week, students created badges, signs, and door designs to help in the battle against drug and alcohol abuse. (continued on page 9)


















Second In District

son Bayou jumped out to a 9-6 first quarter lead, but the Bruins outscored them 25-11 in the second stanza to take a 31-20 half time lead.



Outscored in overtime period 9-5 and dropping two more players to fouls, the Rebels fell 74-70.

















Cherelle ran a 17.08 in the 100-Meter hurdles to claim second place while Stephanie leaped 4-10 to finish second in the high jump.



Third places came from Scott Romero in the discus with a toss of 107-7 and Barry Badon in the 200 with a 23.62.







New Leadership




Kris Kringle Week was given a new twist, with teachers giving FHA members daily gifts. Members enjoyed small gifts that included homemade cookies and candies.


In March, members attended the district convention in Layfayette. After the convention, members shopped at the local mall.
