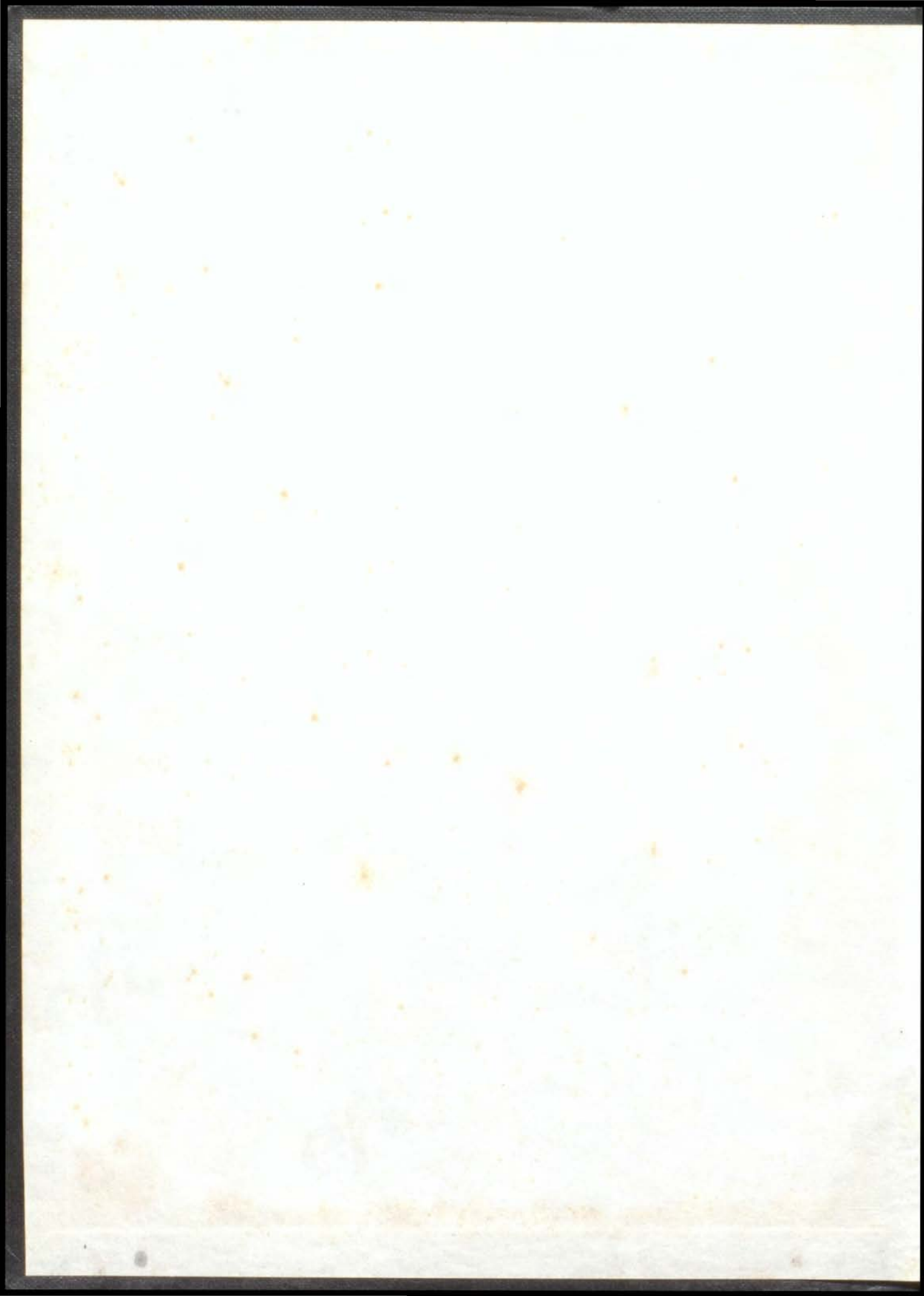
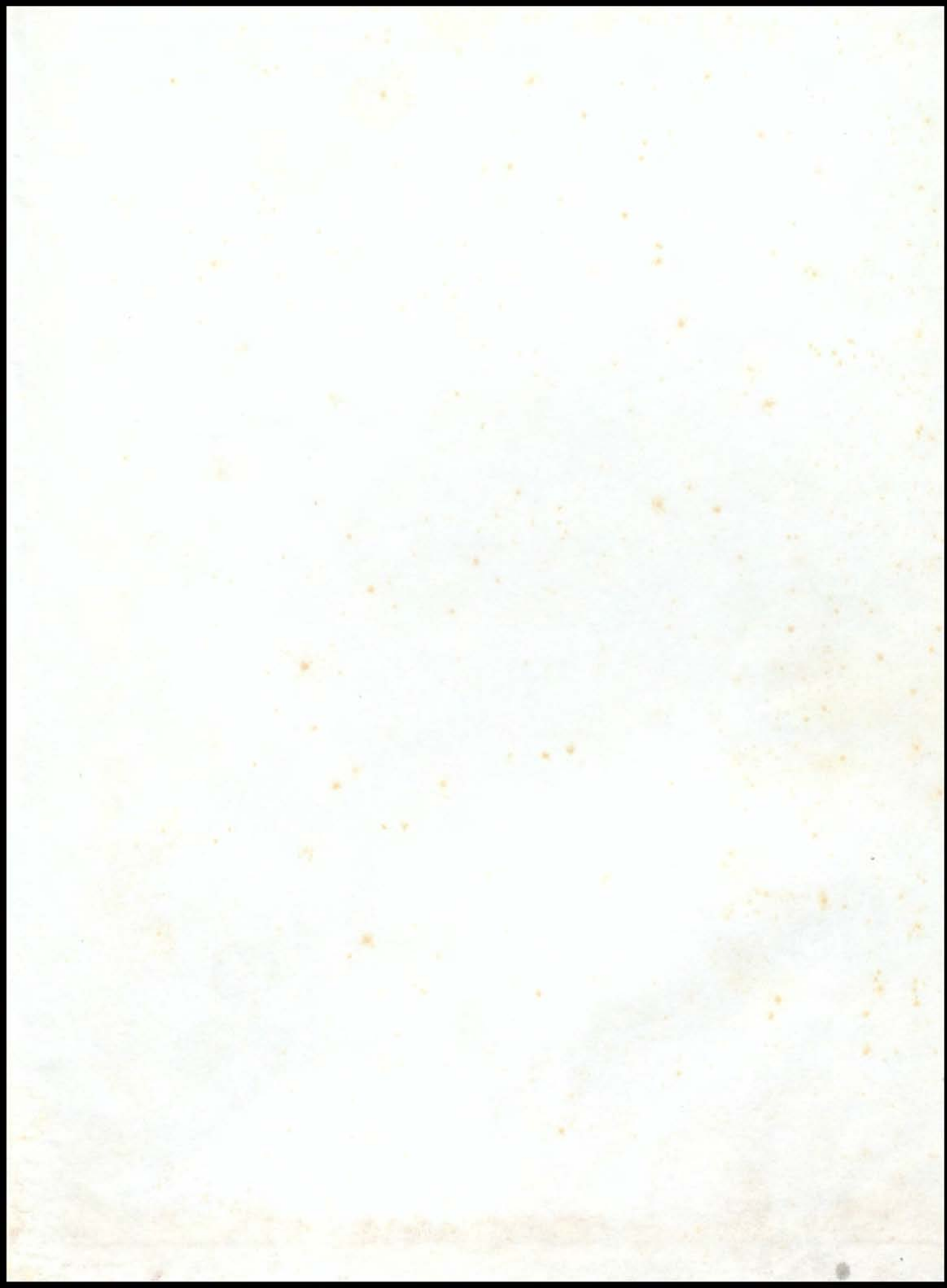

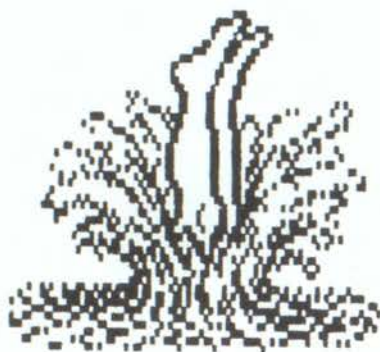


### And Say It With Rebel Pride

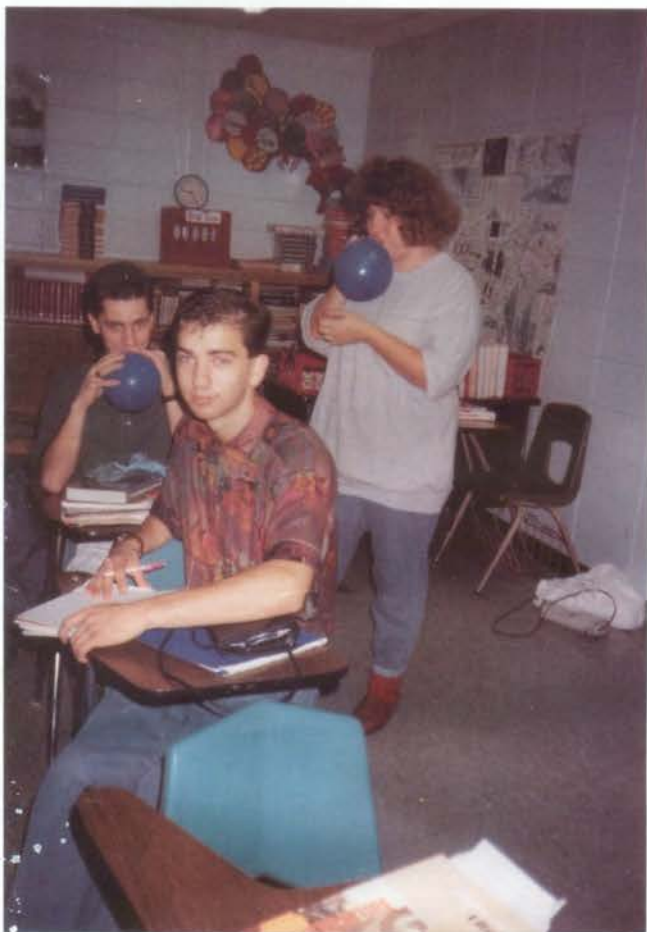

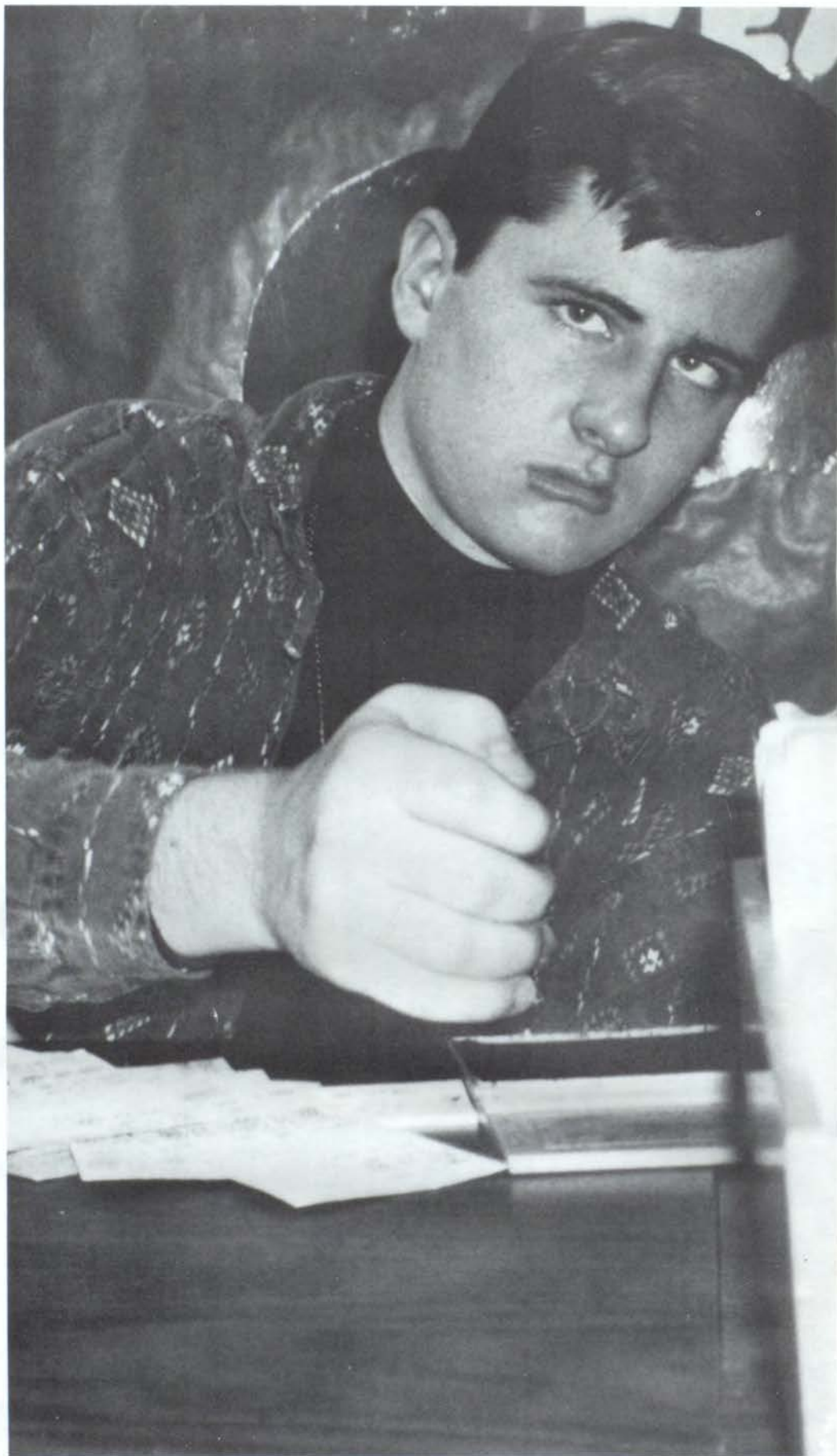

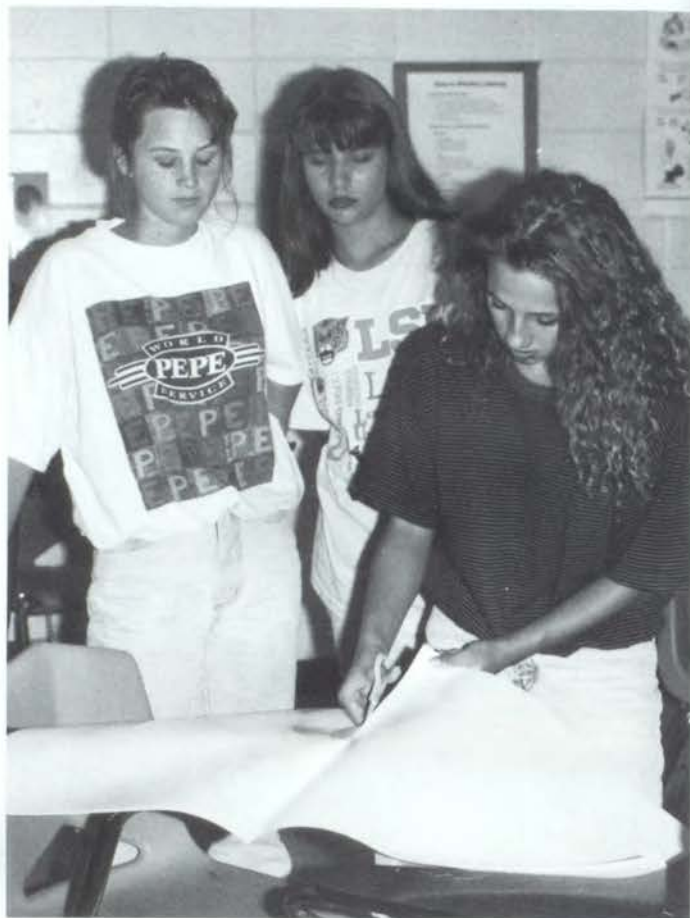

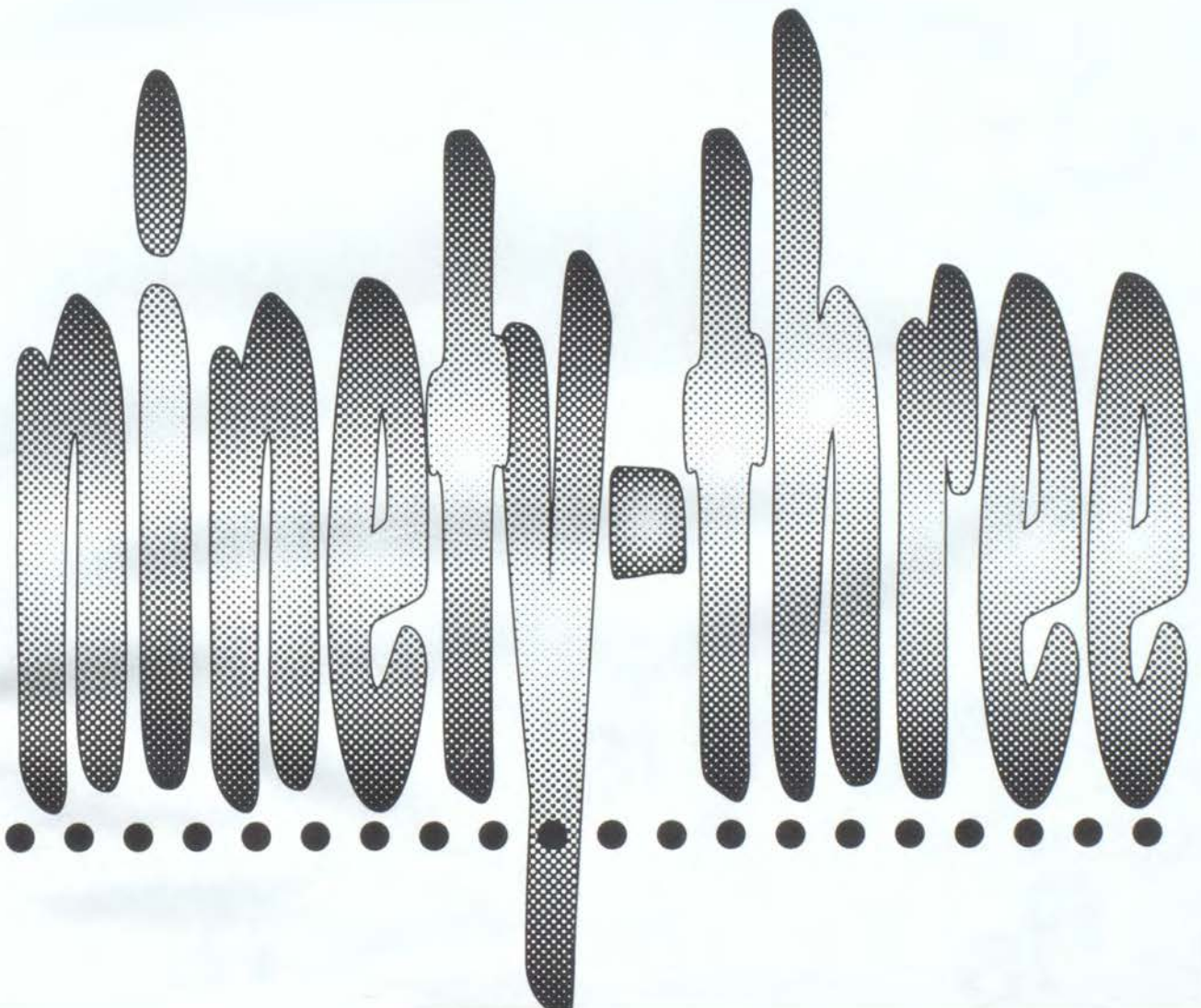

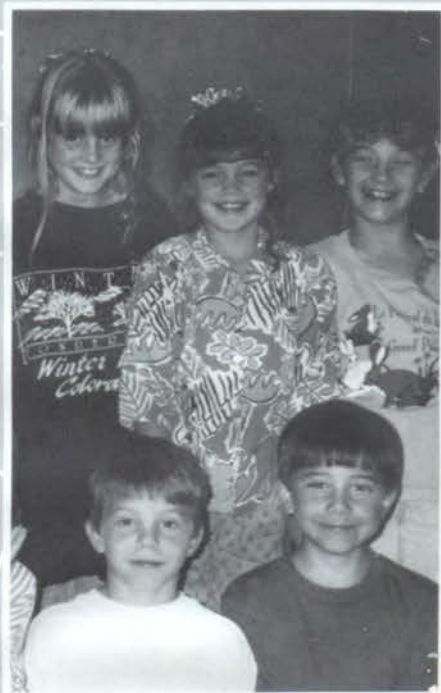
Friday our spirits were brought to a high. There was no turning back for our Rebel guys. Students came dressed in red, blue and gray. The hollering and cheering capped off the day.

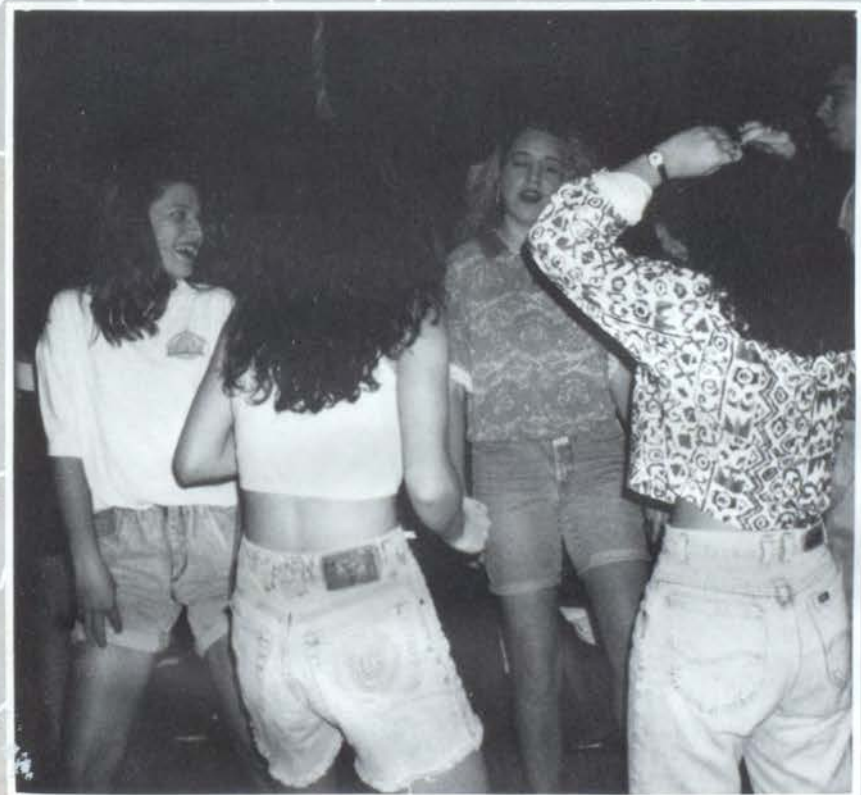
