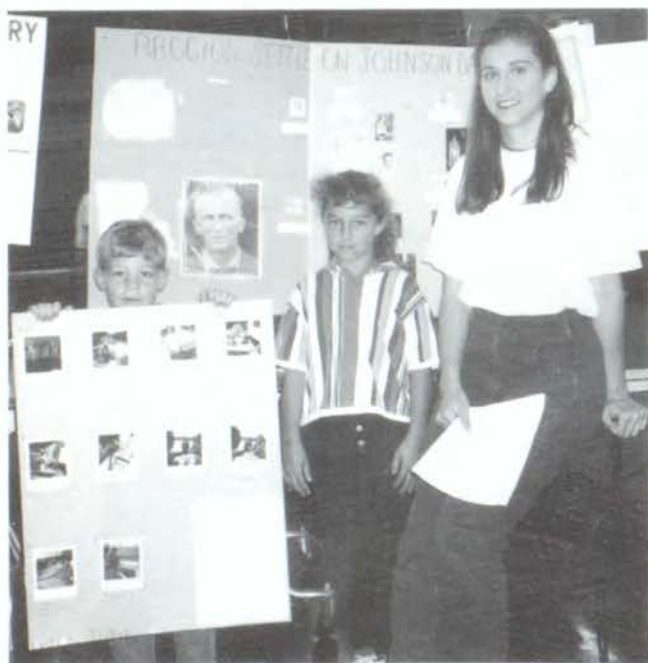


# HISTORY FAIR

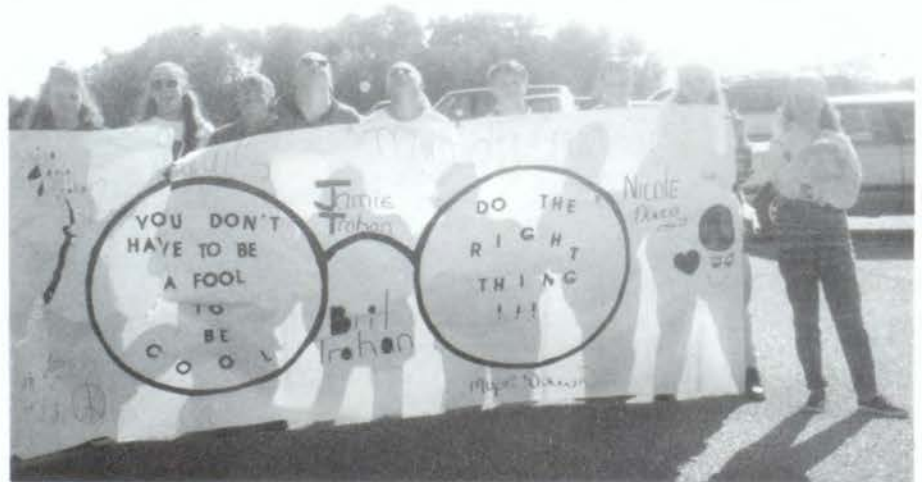
