The school year had started and it was looking to be a great year. Hurricane Katrina hit and our community had become a safe haven for many evacuees. Little did we know that we would soon become victims ourselves. On September 24th, Hurricane Rita hit the southwest corner of our state with a fury. No one ever expected such devastation. The entire parish was drastically affected and everyone was left wondering what to do next. From a school standpoint, Johnson Bayou school had been spared.

Our friends in Cameron and Creole lost all 3 schools as well as their entire communities. All of our Holly Beach residents lost their homes also. Although our devastation was less, we would soon realize that it would be a long time before we walked the halls of 'ole JB again. An important thought on the minds of many was "if" our school would be restored. The school's survival was a determining factor for many as they contemplated returning home and rebuilding. With only a handful of homes spared it was the worst disaster to Johnson Bayou since the early 1900's. For the parish, no one had experienced such tragedy since Hurricane Audrey in 1957. One thing was for sure, our lives would be forever changed and it would be a long time before we would see "normal".





Getting Our Act Together



Dr. Chance quickly declared that all Cameron Parish schools would resume under their own names as quickly as possible. It was decided that Johsnon Bayou would share days with Hackberry and Cameron with Grand Lake. A meeting of parents and students was held to see how many students would return. Students would be bussed from Sulphur and Johnson Bayou so as many students could attend as possible. Hackberry welcomed us and we resumed school on November 1st. Students attended 2 1/2 days a week. Although we were still far from home it was good to see everyone and draw strength from each other. It was the first step on the long road home.














Home games were played at the Spar

dark time for all of us.






The World To Our Rescue






CheniereTo The Rescue
