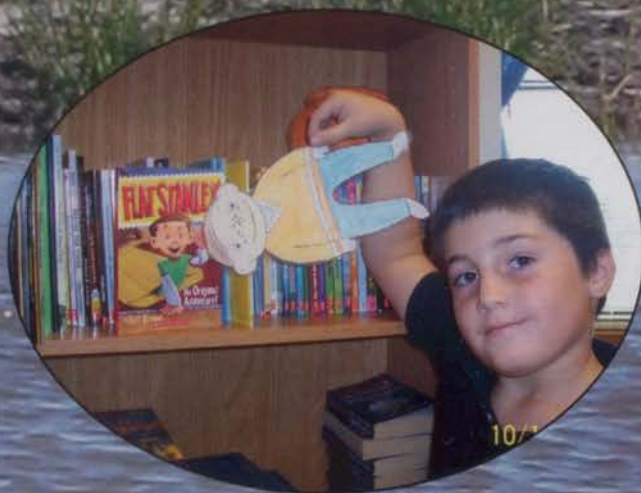
# The Power of Pink
