Kathy Savoie is now the owner of the Gulf Beauty Salon with one assistant hairstylist, Francis Guilbeau, better known as Gismo.

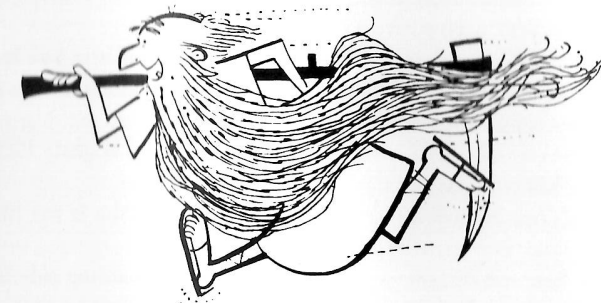
Ted Baccigalopi is the new manager of Sooner's and part-time Harvard professor.
