



#### Twenty-Fifth

This year designates the 25th anniversary of South Cameron High School. The annual staff wishes to acknowledge this by proudly presenting the following section in honor of the many people who have contributed to South Cameron during its 25 years.



South Cameron High School first opened its doors in the fall of 1956 and operated successfully under the superintendency of Mr.

U. E. Hackett and the leadership of Principal R. H. Pittman graduating 35 seniors.

On June 27, 1957, Hurricane Audrey completely destroyed the facilities and eight of its student body: Roger Dale Savoie, Gerald Wayne Theriot, Harmon Mudd, Jr., Betty Anne Conner, Ethel Miller, Belva Boudoin, Edwin Miller, and Betty Jean Clement. Students of South Cameron were transferred to Grand Lake High School and the old Grand Chenier High School during the rebuilding process.





#### Anniversary

In 1958, the doors were reopened to 335 students under the principalship of Mr. U. W. Dickerson and seventeen teachers, teaching grades one to twelve.

The school continued to operate this way until 1969 when the neighboring South Cameron Elementary was constructed to relieve some of the growing pains of South Cameron High School. At that time, the elementary students of the Creole area were transferred to the adjacent school, and once again South Cameron became an 8-12 unit until 1969 when the all black Audrey Memorial joined South Cameron

The school has operated under the superintendency of U. E. Hackett, Wilson Montie, Bobby Smith, and T. W. McCall and under the direct leadership of R. H. Pittman, U. W. Dickerson, J. C. Reina, and Frand Brocato. Donald Broussard has also contributed many years of service to South Cameron. His experience and know-how have helped many people during his time at South Cameron.

South Cameron has enjoyed and suffered practically all experiences any other school has: literary rally champions, successful sports program, state champion livestock exhibitions, honorary band members, vandalism, bomb threats, walk-ins, skip-days, etc.

Twelve hundred and thirty-seven graduating seniors have left South Cameron High School to journey into the world to spread their expertise as professionals down to common laborers.

The school has received accreditation from the Southern Association Accrediting Agency and, therefore, participates in any activity that other member schools do.

The student body and faculty comprise a very diverse group all striving toward one goal — to produce quality members of society. The school serves a vast rural area with busses traveling a total distance of 224 miles and the farthest route a distance of 26 miles. The school community encompasses approximately 836 square miles.








## Other Activities
