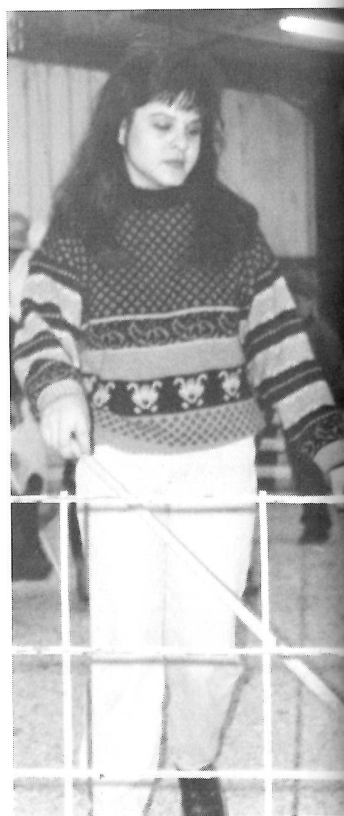


Livestock

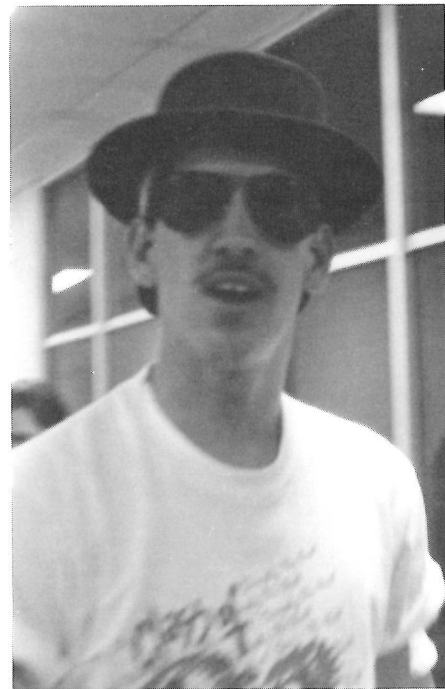


IN THE YEARS TO COME
