

Discussed at 10/20/2008 Library Board Meeting

No quorum so no official meeting

Cameron Branch Library will be built in Cameron. State Library does not tell parishes where to put branches.

Advertisement for Library director being written by Cindy and published until 11/03/2008. Wording for ad will be taken from several ad examples from other parishes. Suggested salary: 45,000 – 60,000 according to experience and education.

Trustee handbooks should be in for Dinah and Gail. Dede will check with state library.

George talked with police jurymen about cleaning up Cameron site and pushing to right-of-way. Dede will call Solinet to see if we need a letter for demo. Storage container in Cameron cleaned out and will be disinfected.

Hackberry branch is all cleaned out and ready for repairs. Shelving units will need to partially replaced because saltwater got the bases, braces, endcaps, and lower shelves. Library Interiors installed the shelves before and Dede will get with them to get a list of shelving.

Library tax election will be held in 2009. Dede will get with state library on wording of the old ballot.

Dede will get library directors salaries from other parishes.

George said the insulation of the GL office had to be removed and should be replaced before cold weather. He recommended spray in foam. Dede will call for estimates.

Service pole is needed for Cameron to bring in a bookmobile. Dede will call for 200 amp service pole estimates with 4 exterior plugs.

Hurricane Café has ^{learned} moved to the old post office spot next to the old thrifty way. The landowner and George has reminded them of where their parking area is.

Gate reports will need to be done for November. CD with forms with Gates files are available. Rhonda will do the reports.
